

**Please pick up your trash and place it in a trash can or a dumpster!**

- Honey Creek is subject to flooding at any time during a heavy rainfall. Park officials will make every effort to warn campers to move to high ground when deemed necessary. Please follow instructions and DO NOT cross barricades or attempt to pass through high water.
- No tent camping in Level 1 or Level 2.
- No pets allowed, only ADA compliant dogs are allowed (emotional support animals are not allowed).
- Climbing on rocks and cliffs is prohibited.
- Beer and other alcoholic beverages are permitted in your camp site or picnic area only.
- Firearms are not permitted inside Turner Falls Park (Including Air Rifles, BB guns, or fireworks). Except for firearms carried pursuant to Oklahoma state statutes.
- If no lifeguards are present, swim at your own risk. Swimming is not allowed after dark.
- For the convenience of our guests please turn off all radios, TVs, and generators at 10:00PM.
- In order to keep our natural beauty, cutting the trees or shrubs is prohibited.
- Please use our footbridges as low water crossings are slick and dangerous.
- Turner Falls Park is NOT responsible for lost or stolen items.
- By purchasing a ticket for Turner Falls Park or any of its activities, the customer agrees to all terms and conditions of the park ([www.turnerfallspark.com/tos](http://www.turnerfallspark.com/tos)) All tickets purchased are non-refundable. In the case of park flooding, all tickets will be exchangeable for later dates. All daily admission tickets are good for only one day from Box Office opening till dark. 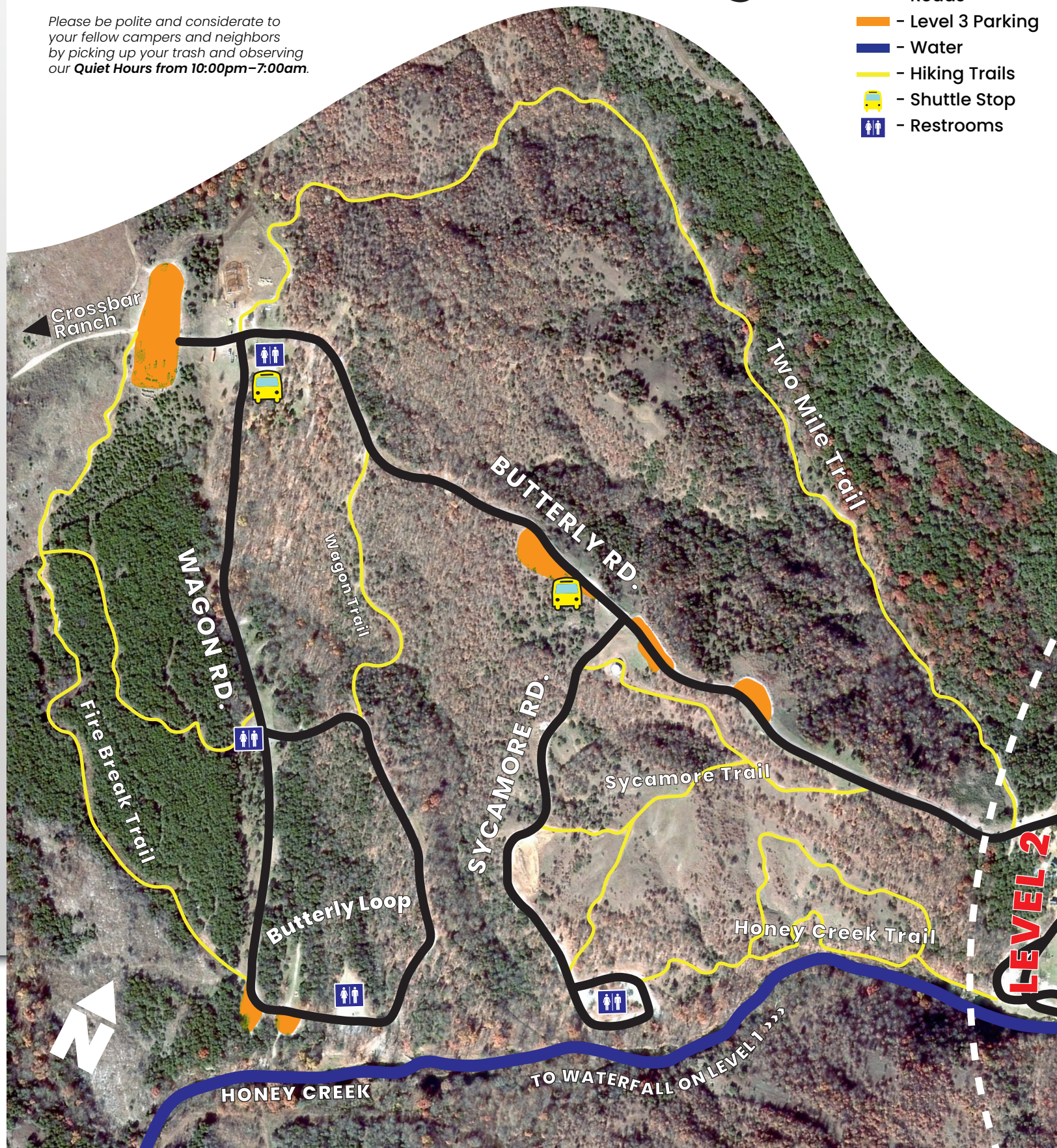

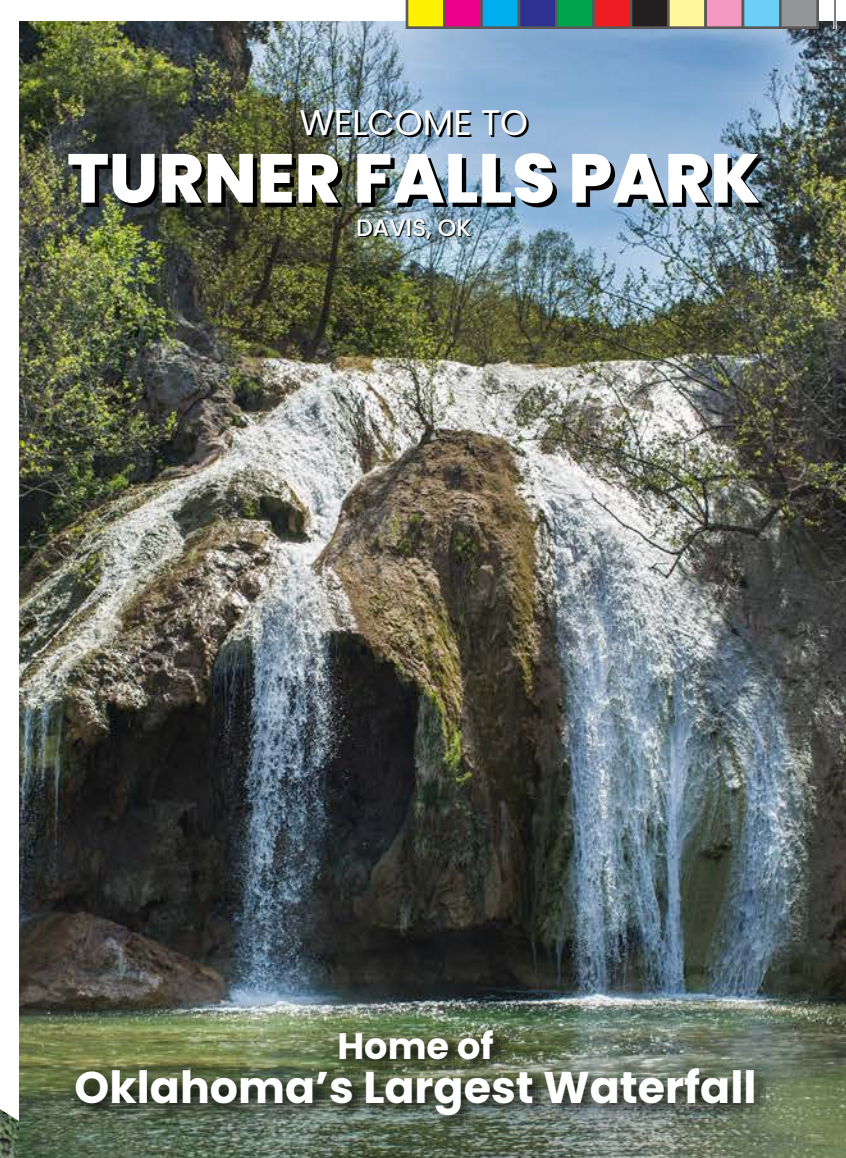

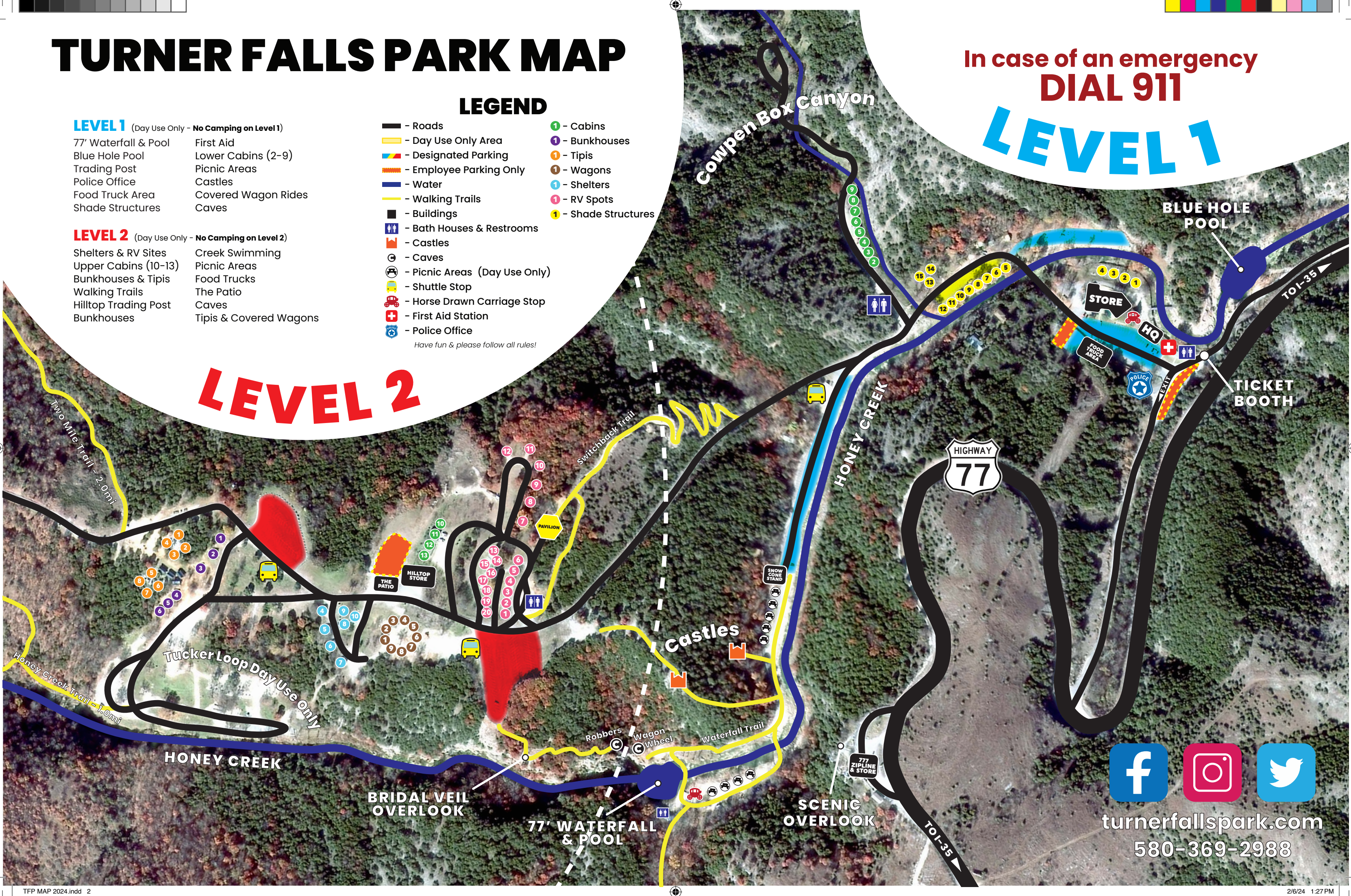
